We are committed to being a business that is both resilient and sustainable. This week, our Sustainability team hosted a number of events and activities to inspire and support colleagues to make more sustainable choices.

Michelle Leavesley, our Group Sustainability Officer, and Keith Davies, our Group Chief Risk Officer, hosted a webinar outlining what we're doing to reach net zero emissions by 2040. The National Trust, Europe's biggest conservation charity that look after nature, beauty and history, also hosted a webinar to explain how our donation is being used to foster climate resilience and enhancing our natural landscapes as part of their Riverlands Programme.
